

VICTORIA WAREHOUSE



Victoria Warehouse was originally a cotton storage facility built by the Liverpool Warehousing Company in the early 1900's. It quickly became a symbol of strength and innovation in the city. Kellogg's, Cadbury and McVities also utilised the space until a major fire damaged the interior in the 1980's.

Restoration began in 2009 and today Victoria Warehouse is a flexible and vibrant event space and a beacon of regeneration and continued innovation in the North West.

The North West is an important contributor to the UK's Innovation Landscape, having particular strengths in Digital Services, Advanced Manufacturing and Emerging Technologies.

As part of the EUREKA Global Innovation Summit we'll also be shining a spotlight on developments within the areas of health and life sciences and the impact the region has on the UK's Ageing Population Grand Challenge. EUREKA is a trusted global network of national ministries and innovation agencies which work together to facilitate business collaboration.

With over 40 countries involved, EUREKA supports collaborative international activities that are innovation focused, commercially orientated and led by businesses.









6,800+ PROJECTS

EUREKA offers the following instruments for countries to collaborate:

- Network projects: transnational market-driven collaborative R&D projects between EUREKA members and associated countries.
- EUREKA Eurostars Programme: a partnership programme between EUREKA and the EU's Horizon 2020 framework programme targeted at research intensive SME's.
- EUREKA Clusters: Longer term, strategic industry-led initiatives in various sectors that aim to develop new technologies key for future competitiveness, and which stimulate links between SMEs and large businesses.
- GlobalStars: collaborative projects between EUREKA countries and partners outside the EUREKA network (third countries).



Each year the chairmanship of the EUREKA network rotates among the member countries. The Chair sustains the momentum of EUREKA's work and represents EUREKA externally. As part of the Chairmanship, the UK is organising the Global Innovation Summit on behalf of the network.
